#### Life Membership Dues

Whereas AMVETS life membership dues have been set at \$250 since January 2012, and,

**Whereas** this is among the lowest price for life membership dues of any Veterans Service Organization, and,

**Whereas** this does not accurately reflect the value of AMVETS life membership, no, therefore,

**Be it resolved** that Article VII, Section 6, a, (1) be replaced with the following:

"Life membership dues, effective September 1, 2023, shall be not less than \$500 for those members age up to and including 55, ages 56 through and including 65 will be \$400 and those 66 and over \$300, nonrefundable, and payable to the post, of which 50 percent shall be forwarded to National Headquarters and 25 percent to the state department."
