A MESSAGE FROM YOUR COMMANDER

I want to say Happy Thanksgiving to all our members...I wish you a *very happy* Thanksgiving with your family and friends for dinner. If you're a member that has nowhere to go, we are having

Thanksgiving dinner being served in our Chappies Lounge Nov. 23rd, 2-4:30PM.

I want to welcome our neighbor downstairs, "The Tacoma Calvary". They have been working hard on getting everything downstairs for their first service on Wednesday Nov. 1st 6:30PM and on Sundays at 10AM. Come join them!

Thank You customers, donors, grantors, vendors and volunteers! You have been a great help throughout the year. Thank you! Thank You!

The monetary contributions, volunteer labor & expertise, reduction in services, sale of surplus items, hall rentals and grants have kept us open for the past six (6) months since our Bingo shut down.

Our expenses for Chappie's Lounge (bar supplies, entertainment, licensing, payroll & taxes) should average \$16K per month. In May & August 2023, we broke even! What you did...what we did, in August,

is what we need to continue doing to keep Chappie's open for the benefit of our membership.

Although we've reduced our building expenses by 86% (less \$96K per month) since February 2023, we are in crisis. Our necessary building expenses are now @ an average of \$17K per month. This includes our commercial insurance, maintenance, utilities, safety & security. A long-term lease for our empty Bingo Hall would help defray our building operating costs.

Today, our Post 1 Building's survival depends on rentals and monetary donations. Please consider AMVETS Alvah R. Dravis Post 1 as a recipient of your generosity. *Thank You.*
