Life Membership Dues

Whereas AMVETS life membership dues have been set at \$250 since January 2012, and.

Whereas this is among the lowest price for life membership dues of any Veterans Service Organization, and,

Whereas this does not accurately reflect the value of AMVETS life membership, no, therefore,

Be it resolved that Article VII, Section 6, a, (1) be replaced with the following:

"Life membership dues, effective September 1, 2023, shall be not less than \$500 for those members age up to and including 55, ages 56 through and including 65 will be \$400 and those 66 and over \$300, nonrefundable, and payable to the post, of which 50 percent shall be forwarded to National Headquarters and 25 percent to the state department."

AUXILIARY

In 2022–2023, forty-eight (48) Aux 1 members participated or volunteered for (323) AMVETS Post 1 meetings, activities, projects, or programs. There were (1 to 10) Aux members who organized activities, cooked meals, manned the Receptionist Desk in the Veterans Service Claims Office, raised funds, and landscaped weekly. Outside the Post, there were six (6) members who promoted AMVETS. Our new Annual membership tripled. Our new Life members count quadrupled.

On Mar. 16, 2020, AMVETS Post 1 closed its doors for a year due to the COVID-19 Pandemic. On Mar. 16, 2023, the AMVETS Post 1 "Family" began a new "Pandemic Recovery" Program. Aux 1 donated \$3,500+ for this endeavor. Since 2021, the "2020–2021 National Award-winning Local Auxiliary of the Year" volunteer team have been most of the Dept Aux leaders & members. Our VAVS Rep & new Honorary Member voluntarily managed "Pandemic Recovery" fundraisers, including: raffles; a \$500+ bake sale; silent auction; and weekly donation collections. So far, they've raised approximately \$5,000 for the cause. Our Dept Aux Hospital Chair & (1 to 6) Aux volunteers provide "Special Menu" food service 2-3 nights a week. Our Dept Aux 1st Vice & Sgt-at-Arms volunteer & donate, regularly, with weekly Post activities, recreation & AMVETS fundraisers. Our Dept Aux President, Treasurer & NEC Woman have volunteered over 264 manhours with Corporate Management. Our Dept Aux Scholarship Chair wrote "Pandemic Recovery" grants totaling over \$100K. Our Dept Aux Chaplain has entertained us & cheered us from the brink of "Nonprofit Burnout." And our Dept Aux 2nd & 3rd Vice have inspired us... that we, too, can overcome.
